Not to Scale



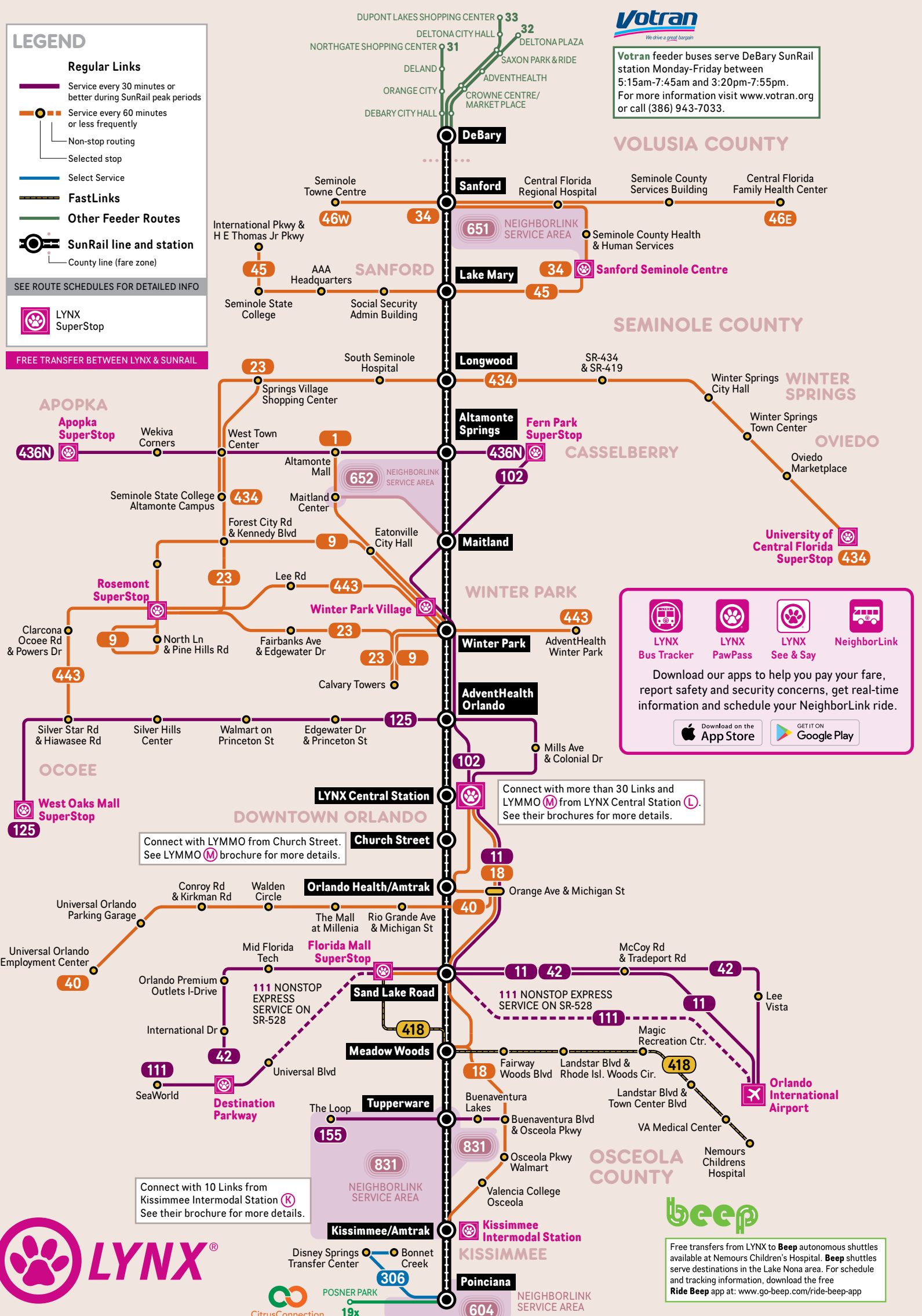

LYNX makes every effort to coordinate connecting bus schedules with SunRail train schedules, however due to changing conditions on local roads and the desire to coordinate schedules with other LYNX routes, a layover may be necessary.
