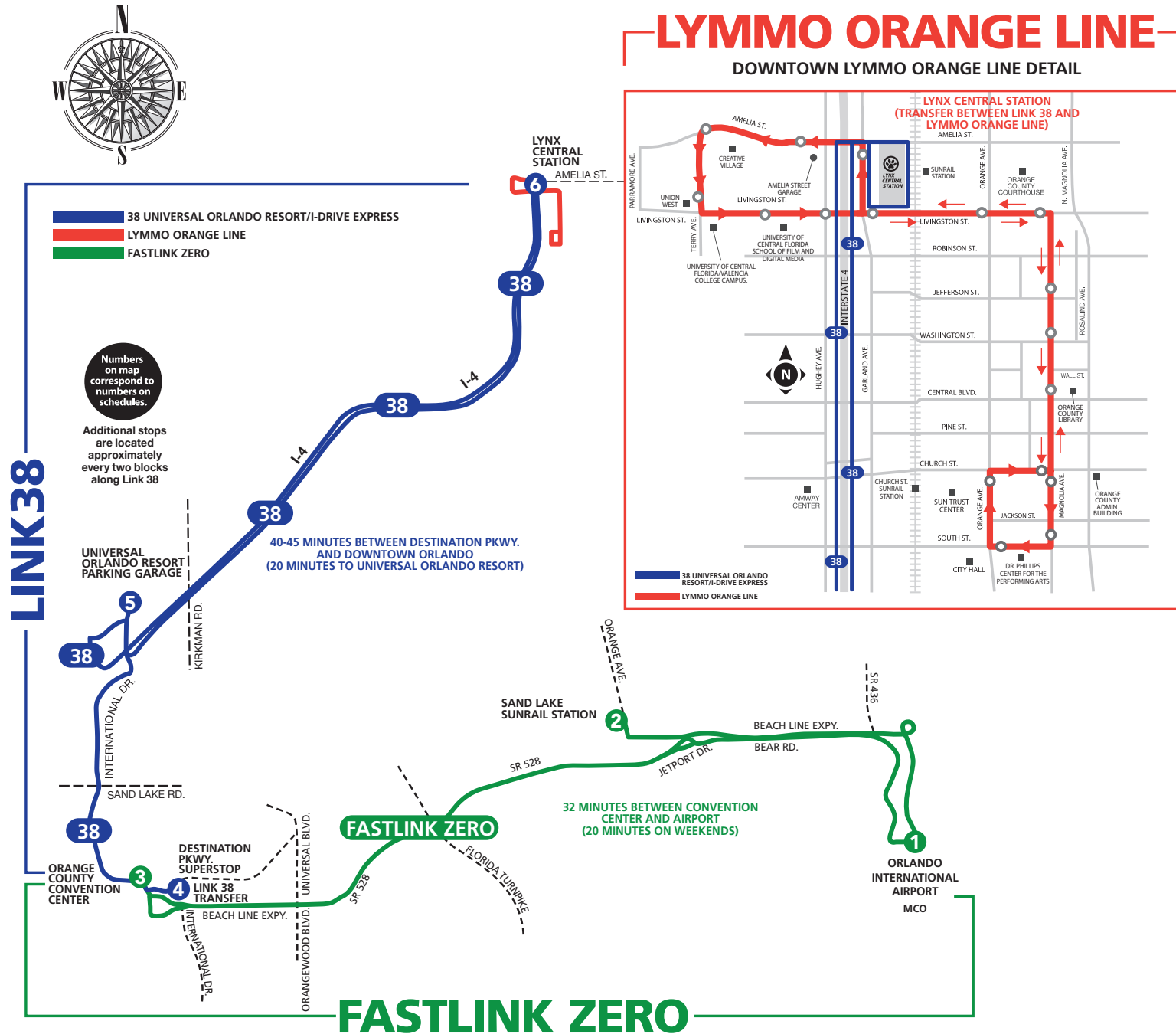

LYMMO ORANGE LINE
The Orange Line directly serves LYNX Central Station and the core of downtown. Passengers can exit the bus stop on South Magnolia Avenue at Church Street for a one block walk to the Orange County Administration Building or at East South Street at South Orange Avenue and cross the street to Orlando City Hall.
